Shimizu port "Ocean Princess"

This sightseeing ship takes passengers on a leisurely cruise around Shimizu Port, one of the three most beautiful ports in Japan. This sightseeing ship with a view of Mt. Fuji behind Miho-no-Matsubara, just like a scene from an ukiyo-e woodblock print, is truly unique to Shimizu Port.



Nihondaira Yume Terrace

Once a true plateau, upheavals have turned Nihondaira into a gently rolling hill. This hill in Shizuoka Prefecture overlooks the Pacific and vast, verdant fields of tea and flowers, with the World Heritage Site—Mt. Fuji, the Southern Alps, and the Izu Peninsula also visible when the weather is clear. A ropeway from Nihondaira connects to the historically significant site, Kunozan Toshogu Shrine.



Museum of Natural and Enviromental History, Shizuoka

This is natural history museum in Suruga Ward, Shizuoka City is the first of its kind in Shizuoka Prefecture with exhibits that explore the theme of global environmental history. Their permanent exhibits cover the nature of Shizuoka and Suruga Bay as well as a variety of living creatures. There is also a photo-shop on site and various events such as lectures and special exhibitions are also held.
